**AUTHORITY FOR RELEASE OF INFORMATION**

Brush Country CASA will complete a record check with the, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Texas Department of Public Safety and the Texas Department of Protective & Regulatory Services on all applicants. This is done to ensure that the applicants have not been convicted of an offense that would be potentially detrimental to the CASA program.

A CASA program does not accept applicants if they have been convicted or have prior charges, or have charges pending for a felony or misdemeanor involving a sex offense, violent act, child abuse or neglect, drug-related offenses identified by T.A.C. (Texas Administrative Code) or related acts that would pose risk to children or to the CASA program's credibility. In order to complete the FBI, police/DPRS report checks, the following information is needed:
